### Pre-School & Primary Education:

All provision is designed to support and develop oracy in the classroom using storytelling and drama.

- **Story Box Sessions** – stand alone participatory oral storytelling sessions.
- **Story Quest Workshops** – Focus on story creation and communication.
- **Storytelling Programs** – regular storytelling provision to support oracy & literacy.
- **Story Builder Clubs** – after school provision to explore stories through both drama techniques and storytelling games.

### Secondary & F.E. Education:

All provision is designed to support the development of transferable oracy skills through harnessing storytelling and drama techniques to equip and empower young people with the tools to communicate confidently and with authenticity.

- **'Step Up & Speak'** workshops in confident communication.
- **Performative Storytelling** workshops introducing how to approach developing story for performance.
- **'My Story, My Voice'** workshops using storytelling to explore topics around Wellbeing.

### Staff Training Programs:

Training programs are designed to provide the opportunity to explore storytelling techniques and their practical application in the classroom and are tailored to meet individual establishment needs and objectives. They can be delivered as a one-off twilight session or as a termly provision and can support staff training days. Minimum session length is 60 minutes.
